LIBRARY DISPLAY POLICY

Displays are selected, designed and arranged solely by Library Staff. No other person, group or organization has authority or permission to erect or maintain any display on the main floor of the Library. All common areas of the Bismarck Public Library, excluding properly scheduled meeting rooms, are not public forum for First Amendment purposes. Temporary displays on the Library building or outside on any Library property must be approved by the Library Director.
